From a straightjacketing definition to the stress on practice

+ Anxiety of identity

Do we still "do" art history?

How do we reshape "art history"

We are not "career" art historians in the traditional Western sense. We confront different contexts. The methods of the old Art History may no longer be relevant to these contexts, e.g. periodisation, connoisseurship, etc

+ Crisis of "old" Art History

in the context of "New" Art Histories

Curriculum Framework

- Content

We agreed on a philosophical Framework/Roadmap based on current practice ("doing" art studies)

Deconstruct



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- The problem of art
- It is not a universal given
- a postcolonial undoing and challenge to existing norms

• Expansion of Parameters

- reconceptualisation of categories
- "diachronic" history to multiple contexts, space and time
- relationship with other disciplines and to determine implications of sharing methods with other disciplines, such as anthropology, area studies, visual culture, cultural studies, etc

Local Knowledge

- enlist other epistemologies
- foreground other contexts of knowing
- not simple celebration of the "indigenous"
- Western civilisation in crisis

- faith in methods
- Art history's intellectual intensity
- Embrace lessons from shifts and turns, and crises
- sympathies for the contemporary
- commitment to the promise of transformation: Public Art Studies
- The disciplines tradition of dissent


